In 2011 the Director General of Health Services (DGHS) discontinued the practice of the '**two-finger**' test but it **is still being practised to determine if the rape survivor is 'habituated to sex'**.

- In an October 2012 verdict, a Madhya Pradesh court held that a rape complainant was "a consenting party" because "Looking to her physical examination, she was habitual to do the intercourse and therefore, she knew about that act but, she did not complain to anybody, till she reached to her house."

- Another Madhya Pradesh verdict of November 2012, quotes the doctor's observation that "the prosecutrix was habitual for intercourse, and therefore two fingers could be inserted in her vagina easily."

In spite of the DGHS discontinuing it, this misogynistic medico legal practice of inserting two fingers in the vagina to check if the rape survivor is 'habituated to sex' continues widely in India. This practice, inherited by India from colonial times, is nothing but medical 're-rape' of the rape survivor. It contributes to India's low conviction rates for rape, by allowing the survivor's past sexual history to undermine her testimony.

In India, people are on the streets against widespread sexual violence and the equally widespread and deep-seated culture of victim-blaming and misogyny that makes it difficult for rape survivors to get justice.

We need you to tell the Government of India to prohibit, without any further delay, the misogynist and degrading medico-legal practice of inserting two fingers in the vagina to check if the rape survivor is 'habituated to sex.'

MTV India and Viacom18: Stop the lewd 'Guess Who' posts
Bollywood, Songs and Television are part of our culture. To know more about their favorite stars billions of young people follow TV channels. Recently, music and entertainment channels have started using facebook as a social-media platform to connect with young people.

MTV India has 3.2 million followers on facebook (<http://www.facebook.com/mtvindia>) and everyday the page asks it's followers to guess a film artist (usually women). **Daily, there is a lewd photograph of a female actors' breasts/thighs/abdomen and the purpose of this activity is for people to guess who she is?**

There has been constant coverage by both mainstream press and independent media about the 23-year old girl who was raped and brutally beaten up by 5 men in a private bus in the city. Though, MTV India felt it was important for them to have a blog up on their website, about how we live in a patriarchal society and it's not just the government and police force, but also us who are responsible for such heinous crimes. They forgot that for months they have been asking people to recognize female actors in our country by their body parts and not by their work or who they are as individuals.

As a matter of fact they are also equally part of this patriarchal society. Through these posts MTV India has not only been objectifying women, but also promoting the idea that **women of only certain size, color and shape are worthy of being featured and thus being recognized by people.** The page hardly features women from other fields and is not a campaign to educate people or inform people about their work.

As a young person who believes to make this country safe it is important for us to respect women - **I am asking MTV India to commit to not posting lewd images of leading female actors and asking people to guess their name.** Such posts are not only offensive, but they also propagate that female actors and models are supposed to be judged by their physical appearance.

If the organization really believes that it's not just the government and laws that have to change, it's time that they practice what they preach.

Take back the President's Police Medal of Gallantry awarded to Ankit Garg

1. In a civilized, constitutional democracy there is no place and there can be no excuse, whatsoever, for torture including sexual violence under any circumstances. It raises serious concerns about the security and dignity of women.

It is deeply shocking that on 26th January 2012 S P Ankit Garg has been conferred with the President's Police Medal for Gallantry. It is disturbing to note that in spite of a large number of citizens' groups, nationally and internationally, protesting against SP Ankit Garg's unlawful and criminal conduct, the government has deemed it fit to confer him with a gallantry award, especially while the Honourable Supreme Court is still examining her complaints. Conferring an award in the face of these complaints, which have not even received a cursory investigation, amounts to condoning the sexual torture inflicted on Ms Sori and the violence which is being perpetrated on tribal population of this country, in the name of anti-Naxal operations.

As the constitutional head of this country, we approach the President with deep regard and faith that he shall ensure that the rights and dignity of the most vulnerable and marginalized will be upheld and the fundamental guarantees promised by the Indian Constitution, of justice, equality and right to life enforced.
